



## **The Spirit of Ringette Scholarship**

The Spirit of Ringette Scholarship has been established to encourage players to continue playing Ringette after the completion of high school, while registered in post-secondary education in Canada. The amount of the scholarship award shall be \$750 per year. Scholarship funds must be applied to the academic year for which the scholarship was awarded. Up to one scholarship per year shall be awarded.

### **Eligibility Criteria**

1. The applicant must have applied to be enrolled full-time in a post-secondary program at a university, community college or technical institute in an undergraduate, professional, graduate, apprenticeship, diploma or certificate program within Canada.
2. The applicant must be registered, or planning to register if registration has not yet opened, to play Ringette with a Ringette Association or club as recognized by a provincial governing body.
3. Applicants must have registered with the Bow View Ringette Association as a player for at least FIVE seasons. (Seasons do not have to be consecutive).
4. The successful applicant will have demonstrated sustained commitment to the sport of Ringette through playing, coaching, officiating, and other volunteer activities within the Bow View Ringette Association.

### **Application Procedure**

1. Applications must be submitted by email to the Scholarship Committee, Bow View Ringette Association, by May 5th.

2. The application must include:
  - A completed application form;
  - Two letters of reference from persons in the Ringette community;
  - Proof of enrolment at, or the receipt of application to, a post-secondary institution (university, college or technical institute) for the upcoming fall semester;
  - Proof of registration, or the intent to register, as an active player for the upcoming season.
3. The successful applicant will be advised of the scholarship by June 1<sup>st</sup>, of the year of application. Presentation of the Spirit of Ringette Scholarship will occur at the Annual General Meeting held in June.
